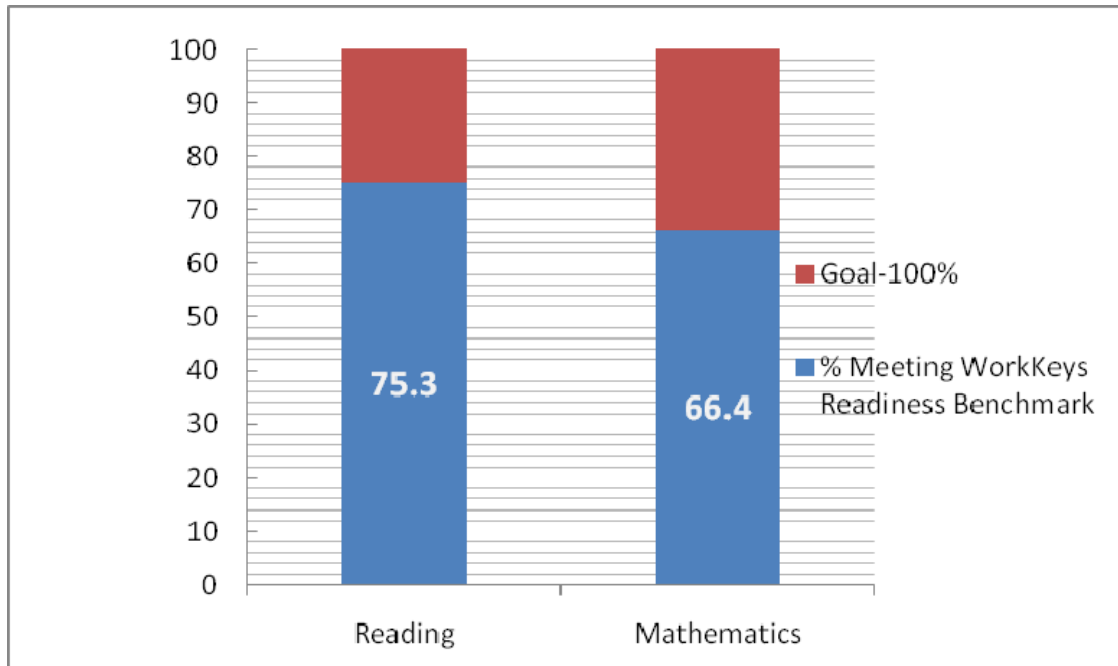


SVHS Graduating Class of 2010 % Meeting Workplace Readiness Benchmarks



This data is provided through the 2009 PSAE report. The information reflects the scores of the graduating class of 2010 who were required to take the ACT WorkKeys assessment during April of their junior year (2009). The ACT WorkKeys Reading for Information assessment measures skills people use when they read and use written texts in order to do a job. The Applied Mathematics assessment measures the skills people use when they apply mathematical reasoning, critical thinking, and problem-solving techniques to work related problems. The WorkKeys score ranges are from 3 to 7. A score of 5 indicates a work readiness skill level to be successful in an occupation that can support a family of four and while providing the opportunity for advancement. One of the District's goals is to have every student "workplace ready" by the time they graduate from Stillman Valley High School.
